Sirens of Gotham has accomplished much since its establishment in November of 2011, but has grown exponentially since February 2013, when the ensemble became a chartered chapter of the world's largest music education organization for women Sweet Adelines International (SAI). Since then, the Sirens have twice claimed the title of SAI Region 15 Division A Champions (first in 2015, and most recently in April 2017), taken 3rd place in the 2015 New York Harmony Sweepstakes, and in 2018, will compete on the international stage for the Sweet Adelines International Harmony Classic barbershop chorus competition in St. Louis, MI. We have appeared on multiple televised broadcasts, starred in a television show, and performed in a variety of world-renowned venues.
