A NOTE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Welcome to our Fifth Tin Pan Alley Quartet Contest! While the contest has evolved a bit from the early years, we are so glad to have you here as this is one of Voices of Gotham's favorite events of the year.

Each year, our chorus members (and anyone else!) get to flex their quartetting muscle in a friendly competition to Win the Tin as the year's best Novice Quartet! For the purposes of this contest, a Novice Quartet is defined as having no more than 2 members that have competed at a District-level quartet contest (via qualifying at a smaller divisional contest). Some of the people you see on stage today will be performing for the public in a quartet for the VERY FIRST TIME!

In the spirit of progress, we have a couple changes this year that we hope will make the event even more enjoyable. First, we've invited our sisters in song to participate by allowing all-female and mixed quartets in the contest. In addition, we have created the Flat Foot Four Award which will be awarded to the best quartet overall without a need for having novices (though they are certainly allowed). We hope that this "open" category will foster more quartet fluidity rather than the somewhat intricate novice rangling that sometimes occurs. We are hoping to have more people and more quartetting this year than ever before!

Please sit back and support all of participating quartets in what is sure to be another fun and memorable Tin Pan Alley contest!
